

Instructional Programs

St. John the Evangelist School accommodates a full-day Pre-School, Kindergarten, and 1st through 8th grades. The grades are grouped into four categories:

- PRE-SCHOOL: 3, 4, and 5 year old children who are not yet enrolled in a Kindergarten program. The Curriculum will include Religion, Story Time, Small Group Activities, Math, Science, Socialization Activities, and many more exciting learning experiences

The 3 year old Pre-School program will meet two days a week for 2¼ hours each day (Tuesday & Thursday). Morning and Afternoon sessions or a Full Day option are available.

The 4 and 5 year old Pre-School program will meet three days a week for 2½ hours each day (Monday, Wednesday, and Friday). Morning and Afternoon sessions or a Full Day option are available.

- PRIMARY: Kindergarten, 1st, 2nd, and 3rd
- INTERMEDIATE: 4th and 5th
- MIDDLE SCHOOL: 6th, 7th, and 8th



The Kindergarten through Eighth grade curriculum consists of a standard program including the following courses:

- Spelling
- Writing
- English
- Religion
- Math
- Science
- Spanish
- Social Studies
- Health
- Computer Education
- Music
- Physical Education
- Art

Curriculum Highlights

Language Arts - Literature based reading programs.

Math – Reasoning and computation, Pre-Algebra and Algebra offered in 7th & 8th grades.

Art & Physical Education – Taught by part-time faculty members that are fully certified by the State of Illinois.

Computer Instruction – Taught by a full-time faculty member.

Music Instruction – Offered at all grade levels, featuring student performances at our annual Christmas and Spring Concerts.

All full-time faculty members are certified by the State of Illinois.
