We received full accreditation with exemplary recognition and The Archdiocese evaluated our curriculum and found that the students and staff are working to their full potential. We had numerous field trips including, Feed my Starving Children, the Museum of Science and Industry, and other educational trips. With every free minute she has, I have promised to bring her in the office and explain what is necessary to be an administrator. Dear Parent/ Guardian:

St. John the Evangelist is offering a Summer Vacation Tutoring Program to assist students with basic math and literacy skills. This program is available to every St. John's student grades PK4-4th.

Sessions will be available in the school in the Computer Lab. Session times can be decided on between the tutor and the parent. The sessions are available beginning on June 11th and ending on August 1st (No tutoring 4th of July week).

The cost of this tutoring will be \$40 per hour or \$20 for a half-hour. This payment may be in the form of cash, check, or Venmo. Payment times will be determined between you and the tutor.

What are the benefits?

The benefit of this program is to prepare your child for the upcoming school year and to keep their abilities strengthened during the summer.

Do I need to arrange transportation?

Yes. The parent is responsible for dropping off and picking up their child at the arranged times.

Do I need to supply any materials?

No. All workbooks and other supplies will be provided to the student.

Is homework assigned?

There will be homework assigned depending on the wants of the parent and the tutor. It is on an individual basis.

How will I know how my child is doing?

There will be constant communication between the tutor and the parent.

What do I need to do as a parent?

You and your child will be asked to sign the attached contract in which you agree to your child attending the Summer Vacation Tutoring Program.

Please indicate your interest in having your child participate in the Summer Vacation Tutoring Program by signing the attached contract and returning it to school by **Monday, June 3, 2019**.
